This agreement is made between the authorized representative of _____ and Tennessee Centennial. The club will allow the use of the facilities for the purpose of holding a golf tournament, upon the following conditions and terms.

The above organization agrees to pay for any and all damages suffered by Tennessee Centennial that is not considered normal wear and tear. The Organization expressly holds Tennessee Centennial harmless for any claim of personal injury or claim of liability by any of its participants or volunteers.

Golf Agreement: The price for your event will be \$ _____ per player. Final Menu to be determined 14 days prior to the event by _____. This includes the use of the course, clubhouse, golf cars, practice balls, golf club staff including PGA Professionals, tournament scoring capabilities, and rules officials. The organization is responsible for a \$ _____ non-refundable deposit due the date the contract is signed in order to reserve your event. The organization is responsible for final payment on the day the event is held. There will be a \$250.00 service charge for any event that is not paid for within 7 business days of the event, unless otherwise agreed upon.

Group Terms and Conditions:

1. Group reservations are considered definite and the terms of this agreement are considered final upon receipt of this signed contract.
2. A \$ _____ non-refundable deposit is due to Tennessee Centennial on the date the contract is signed. Once your deposit and signed contract have been received the terms of this agreement are considered final.
3. Final payment is due _____.
4. All itemized golf charges must be reviewed and signed at the conclusion of the function. If you are not available or choose not to sign, you accept billing count of Tennessee Centennial.
5. DRESS CODE: In staying with the true spirit of the game, proper attire is required. We do allow denim. No Shoes, NO Shirt, NO Play. Tennessee Centennial is a non-metal spike property.
6. The group will be responsible for costs of any damage to the golf course above and beyond normal play and/or golf carts in addition to lost or damaged rental clubs during the golf outing.
7. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL TENNESSEE CENTENNIAL SERVE OR ALLOW SERVICE OF ALCOHOL TO A MINOR. IF MINORS IN YOUR GROUP ARE FOUND TO BE SERVING THEMSELVES ALCOHOL OR ARE BEING SERVED ALCOHOL BY ANOTHER PARTY IN THE GROUP, THE OUTING/EVENT WILL IMMEDIATELY BE SHUT DOWN AND NO MONEY WILL BE REFUNDED.**
8. The final player list should be emailed to the General Manager, Mike Callender, PGA at mcallender@oakridgetn.gov no later than 48 hours prior to the event to allow proper set up. The Tournament Coordinator will be responsible for all hole assignments.
9. Prior to and after shotguns, the course will be open for Member play unless other arrangements have been made in writing with the Tournament Coordinator or General Manager.
10. The Tennessee Centennial logo may not be used without written consent of the General Manager of Tennessee Centennial. Tennessee Centennial's logo may not be used on any merchandise or apparel unless it is ordered through Tennessee Centennial golf shop.
11. A signed contract is due within 15 days of the Contract Date, after which time Tennessee Centennial reserves the right to modify.
